

NO-SEW WEAVING WORKSHOP
Saturday, June 30TH, 2018
40 1st Street, Second Floor, Reno, NV
9am-1pm

We are having a half day workshop focused on no-sew weaving techniques to make your own fabric (small items as inserts to quilts, flaps on wallets, mug-rug/coasters, etc). We will focus on fabric/ribbon strip weaving (rather than the pin weaving) for the workshop. We'll start with the tumbling block motif first as it is the easiest to learn and do correctly (blocks are interlocking), then try some other patterns (as done for the samples).

There will be a sample setup for pin weaving so you can compare with the fabric weaving.

I strongly suggest you prepare the strips for fabric weaving (I figured it was taking me about 1 hour to make strips and much more than that to weave them!). Bring at least 6 WOF strips each of Light, Medium, Dark fabrics .

Materials needed:

- fabric cut in strips (1-1.5" strips folded raw edges to center and pressed) OR packaged bias tape OR ribbon (option to using fabric strips - 1/2-1" wide is a good start)
- light-weight FUSIBLE interfacing (woven or non-woven) - 1/4 yard will suffice
- GLASS HEAD PINS - essential to affix your strips initially and as you work - glass head since you will be ironing over them!
- elastic threader or EZ-pull bodkin and large eye/blunt yarn needle to help you weave fabric
- blunt/thin poker to help ease fabric through slots of fabric (nail file, popsicle stick can work)

Materials provided by the kit (included in workshop price):

- covered and padded posterboard working surface (with appropriate guidelines drawn)

Materials ASG will provide

- Centralized ironing and cutting (mat) stations for group (you bring your scissors/rotary cutter)
- I'll bring a sewing machine so you can secure the outside of your woven piece (after fusing to interfacing)
- I'll provide speciality yarns for pin weaving

FEE/person:
